



God In The Storm

"The voice of the LORD is upon the waters; the God of glory thunders, the LORD is over many waters. The voice of the LORD is powerful, the voice of the LORD is majestic. The voice of the LORD breaks the cedars; yes, the LORD breaks in pieces the cedars of Lebanon. He makes Lebanon skip like a calf, and Sirion like a young wild ox. The voice of the LORD hews out flames of fire. The voice of the LORD shakes the wilderness; the LORD shakes the Wilderness of Kadesh" (Psalm 29:3-8).

For those who have an eye to see it, the wonder of God can be seen all around us; in the darkened sky, the sea, the towering mountains, and even the placid meadows. In this case, the psalmist sees God's unmatched power in the thunder, lightning, and rain that were racing across the landscape.

The description of the violent weather is the heart of the psalm; it is one of the most sublime pictures of a thunderstorm found anywhere in the Scriptures. In verses 3 and 4, the storm is approaching. In verses 5 through 7, the storm descends in its fury. In verses 8 and 9, it trails away in the distance, leaving with us its profound impressions about God.

The writer sees the beginning of the tumult: "The voice of the Lord is upon the waters; the God of glory thunders, the Lord is over many waters." The storm begins over (what must have been) the western Mediterranean Sea with claps of thunder. From a distance, one can see the building of the clouds. Although the sea is strong and destructive, the psalmist knows that God is stronger than the sea. The peals of the thunder are "upon" the sea or "over" it, illustrating to David the sovereignty of God. He is "over" all things, even the world of nature. In the storm, the writer sees the greatness of God. He notices that God is stronger than the crash of the thunderbolt, the fire of the lightning, and the shaking power of the wind.

Key Thought: Our Lord is bigger than the mountains, the seas, and the heavens. He commands the floods, the trees, and the raging rivers. The Creator is above all that He has created. TFT Daily Devotionals
