In this show as well as others the characters would be sitting "at large" in their vehicles and get a call on the radio: "calling all cars, calling all cars, please proceed to" When they received this call, usually there was an urgent situation; it needed to be dealt with right away; any available cars were requested to go to this urgent situation.
