Some Web Site Reporting

Let's talk about our web site. We had a record number of 1788 page-views in October. There were 760 visitors, which means that each visitor looked at an average of 2.3 pages on our web site. These visitors came primarily from the United States, but we had several from foreign countries as well, 34 in total. Of note, we had 37 visitors from the Philippines, 27 from India, 16 from Brazil, 14 from the UK, 13 from Norway, 12 from Russia, 10 from Kenya, 3 from Malaysia, 3 from Saudi Arabia, 1 from Turkey, and 1 from Taiwan. Our web site is getting traffic from all over the world, and so we are taking the gospel to the world!

You may wonder how your dollar is doing toward our web site. Well, to hand out 1788 tracts, at \$.50 per tract, would cost about \$894.00. Our web site costs about \$20 a month. This means that each page that we served, in October, cost a little over 1 cent per page. That's a pretty good deal! The more information we put on our web site, the more pages we will serve up decreasing our cost per page-view even more. You can't get a value like that from a printed tract!

What is great about the web site is that people get the information that they are interested in. Every person who visits our web site, visits because they want to visit. I've had some preachers tell me that they were preaching my sermon outlines. I think that is fine. I've even heard my own sermon outline preached one time! It is great to see the material being used in more locations than just one. You are doing a great work by supporting our web site.
