Why Make Sacrifices (Part 3)?

Have you ever been in love with someone so much that you were willing to do anything? Men will sacrifice their hard earned cash to go out and buy that special girl in their life a precious jewel. Women will work their fingers to the bone to take care of and provide for their children. We sacrifice our time, our money, and ourselves for the things that we love the most. Do we think about God in this way?

The Bible teaches that we are to make sacrifices to show our love for God. In 2 Corinthians 8, the apostle Paul encouraged the church at Corinth to give sacrificially. He says in 2 Cor.8:8, "I speak not by commandment, but by occasion of the forwardness of others, and to prove the sincerity of your love." If they were really sincere about loving God, then they were going to make sacrifices for Him. In this instance, their giving would prove the sincerity of their love for God. Either they really loved God, and were sincere about it, or they didn't love God and were hypocrites, only appearing to love God. The difference between these two is what each is willing to sacrifice. Therefore, sacrificial giving is one way to show that we truly love God. Paul gives the example of the sacrifice of Christ in the next verse (9): "For ye know the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, that, though he was rich, yet for your sakes he became poor, that ye through his poverty might be rich." His sacrifice demonstrated His love for God (John 14:31). God wants us to be a living sacrifice for Him every day (Romans 12:1-2). Such really demonstrates our love for God!

Has God Forgotten Us?

"Yet You have rejected us and brought us to dishonor, and do not go out with our armies. You cause us to turn back from the adversary; and those who hate us have taken spoil for themselves. You give us as sheep to be eaten and have scattered us among the nations. You sell Your people cheaply, and have not profited by their sale. You make us a reproach to our neighbors, a scoffing and a derision to those around us. You make us a byword among the nations, a laughing stock among the peoples. All day long my dishonor is before me and my humiliation has overwhelmed me, because of the voice of him who reproaches and reviles, because of the presence of the enemy and the avenger" (Psalm 44:9-16). God had worked miraculously and providentially for Israel in the previous years. The writer has praised God for these glorious deeds as he lays the groundwork for a special appeal that he is eager to make. As the psalm turns from Israel's past to the present, the writer wrestles with the silence and aloofness of God. He says, "Lord, I have a problem!" He wonders why he cannot see the mighty hand of God defending the Israelites in his day as He did in the past. "Where are the miracles I have heard about? Where is Your mighty power?" he asks. What he fails to see God doing, His actions become more and more detailed as the psalm unfolds. It looks to him that God has turned away from them. "Yet You have rejected us and brought us to dishonor, and do not go out with our armies." He thinks of God as rejecting His people, forcing them to face their enemies with merely their own strength; and this fact has resulted in their defeat. It seems to him that God has brought about their downfall. "You cause us to turn back from the adversary; and those who hate us have taken spoil for themselves." Because they have gone to battle without God's help, he argues, they have been beaten and embarrassed. **Key Thought**: The writer will later discover that life around him is not what it seems to be. The old saying is really true: "When we cannot see His hand, we must trust His heart." Most of the time, life is not what it seems to be. Behind the dim unknown, God rules over His world.
