The Nature of Sin

“Transgression speaks to the ungodly within his heart; there is no fear of God before his eyes. For it flatters him in his own eyes concerning the discovery of his iniquity and the hatred of it. The words of his mouth are wickedness and deceit; he has ceased to be wise and to do good. He plans wickedness upon his bed; he sets himself on a path that is not good, he does not despise evil” (Psalm 36:1-4).

Verses 1 through 4 of this psalm comprise a piece of wisdom literature that instructs concerning wickedness. It reminds us of some of the wisdom passages in Proverbs. The psalm begins by presenting evil as a kind of oracle in our hearts. What does this sinister prophet say? Naturally evil seeks to guide one into its paths. As part of our hearts, it takes over the leadership of our lives. We are dominated by it. Deep within us, it whispers its message of direction and devilment. It is a flatterer. When one has second thoughts about his choice, evil reassures him by telling him that he has made the best choice. It declares that it takes one of the smartest people to make this decision. It reinforces and strengthens the horrible choice that has been made. It will even speak through one's lips. Before one knows it he is declaring its message with the deceitful words that stream from his heart through his mouth. The citadel of the soul has been captured and is now used as the headquarters of wickedness. He has become the instrument of evil.

Key Thought: We understand the rationale behind giving our minds, bodies, and futures to that which is noble, right, and true; but evil asks us to give up everything for that which is hurtful, destructive, and humiliating. The ones taken in by evil have been duped. The only way evil can get one to make such a sacrifice is for the person to be hoodwinked from the inside into believing he has chosen the best way, when in reality he has chosen the worst way.
