We rejoice that this prisoner has been studying God's word and that he desires to be baptized Scott Overstreet was able to visit with him for a few minutes last week and talk to him about his spiritual needs. I am so thankful for brother Scott and the good work he does in the prison ministry. Please lift him and his work up in prayer this week.

I also learned that there was a web site through which you can communicate with prisoners: jpay.com. For the price of a stamp, you can send a one-page document to any prisoner in the State of Texas Correction System. The cost is minimal and you will make a difference in someone's life.

There are more types of prisons than just the physical ones in which we incarcerate those who have been found guilty of crimes. There are prisons that are a lot worse than that. I am talking about the prisons that we create for ourselves spiritually, but Jesus gives us the truth so that we can be set free (John 8:32). Addiction is a deadly prison that will destroy us if we do not do something about it. We can be addicted to many different things: food, caffeine, nicotine, drugs, pornography, sex, power, money, envy, anger, and pride. Peter wrote, "for by whom a person is overcome by him also he is brought into bondage" (2 Peter 2:19). Are you in a spiritual prison?
