The Bible Drill contest between a team of children and a team of adults ended in a tie. Congratulations to all who participated.

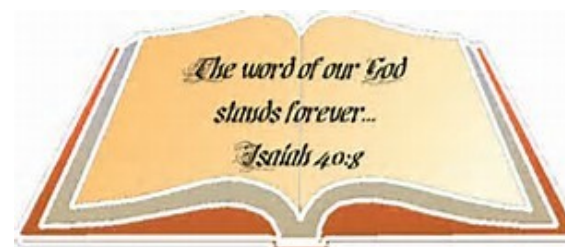
