We had visits from forty-seven (47) different countries. However, through the Internet, we are able to get access. The total number of page-views that we had for the month of August was 1,689 from 535 different visitors.

We are all blessed by God. Perhaps we do not realize just how much God blesses us. When we sit down to think about it, we come away amazed with how much He does for us. There are numerous examples in the Bible and in our own lives when God has gone above and beyond what we can imagine (Eph. 3:20).

One great example of this is found in Genesis 48:11. Jacob (Israel) thought his son Joseph had died years earlier when his other sons brought Joseph's coat covered in blood. For years Israel mourned the death of his beloved son. Then, much to his surprise, he found out that Joseph was indeed still alive. Not only that, but that he was second in command over all Egypt. Notice Israel's response to this news in Genesis 45:26-28.

They told him, saying, "Joseph is still alive, and indeed he is ruler over all the land of Egypt." But he was stunned, for he did not believe them. When they told him all the words of Joseph that he had spoken to them, and when he saw the wagons that Joseph had sent to carry him, the spirit of their father Jacob revived. Then Israel said, "It is enough; my son Joseph is still alive. I will go and see him before I die."

Israel speaks of the great blessings of God in Genesis 48:11 when he says, "I had not thought to see your face; but in fact, God has shown me your offspring!" God went above and beyond any and all blessings that Israel could have imagined. Not only did he get to see his son Joseph again, but he also was blessed to see Joseph's children as well.

God is pictured as a Father who loves to give His children good gifts (Matt. 7:11). God is able to bless us in ways that we cannot even imagine. May we always be thankful and aware of God's blessings in our lives!
