I am excited to announce that Kris Groda will be hosting our Spring gospel meeting March 26-29th, 2017. His topic will be *The Grace of Our Lord Jesus Christ*. This meeting will focus on God's grace through Christ Jesus. Second Corinthians 8:9 is the theme verse for this meeting: "For you know the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, that though He was rich, yet for your sakes He became poor, that you through His poverty might become rich." John wrote, "And of His fullness we have all received, and grace for grace. For the law was given through Moses, but grace and truth came through Jesus Christ" (John 1:16-17).
