**Follow The Rules!?**

Phariseeism begins with seemingly harmless and very practical rules. What is wrong with washing hands before eating? That seems like a sensible thing to do, especially if you have dirt on your hands. Why shouldn't we make that a rule? It's for the public benefit, and it's just common sense—very practical, and sensible (but Matthew 15:1-2). Isn't it also a good idea to wash the outside of the cup? Dirty cups are very unattractive, and they make me think that the inside isn't clean. Surely this is a practical and sensible rule (but Matthew 23:25-26). If there is one thing that gets on my nerves, it's a cemetery that has a bunch of weeds growing up in it. Why would people let such a place get into such bad shape like that? It's just practical and sensible to cut the grass (but Matthew 23:27-28). Another thing: don't do the Lord's work on your day off. If you have a day off, that should be for you, and your family.

Certainly don't try to visit someone in the hospital, take food to a poor person, or make an orphan's day better. It's just practical and sensible to make sure that you take care of your own first (but Luke 10:25-37). What practical, sensible person would tell you to hate your own father and mother (but Luke 14:26)? What practical, sensible person would tell you not to go to your own father's funeral (but Matthew 8:21-22). What practical, sensible person would destroy 2000 head of livestock (but Mark 5:13)? Jesus was not practical and sensible; He was extreme, radical, revolutionary. I know what you're going to say, "But Kevin . . . ." My reply: "Yes, but Jesus."

## True Worship

"Hear, O My people, and I will speak; O Israel, I will testify against you; I am God, your God. I do not reprove you for your sacrifices, and your burnt offerings are continually before Me. . . . He who offers a sacrifice of thanksgiving honors Me; and to him who orders his way aright I shall show the salvation of God" (Psalm 50:7, 23).

Using our Lord's judgment of His Old Testament people as an example, mark out the essential elements of pure religion before God. These determinations will be easy to make. This fact is true because we see in this psalm that sincere religion in God's sight is clearly defined. God Himself defines it. In His view, righteousness has two elements: worship from the heart and godly living. These two traits are inseparable. One without the other is insufficient and unacceptable to God. Can we not say that the lesson of this psalm is just as vital today as it was when given? The Old Testament context was that of animal sacrifices and temple worship, while the context for the Christian is the last days, the Christian Dispensation. The New Testament church worships through singing, preaching, prayer, communion, and giving as it looks to God in faith and love. Even though we live in a different dispensation from the time of this psalm, the lesson it gives is relevant and is repeated in the New Testament. Worshiping God from the heart and living out His words in our darkened world are mandated by both covenants. If God called us before Him today for correction, what would He say? Would He rebuke us for our lack of heart in His worship and our lack of faithfulness in living out His will?

Key Thought: "He who offers a sacrifice of thanksgiving honors Me; and to him who orders his way aright I shall show the salvation of God" (50:23).
