

THE SMALL ONES COUNT, TOO

An airplane one degree off its course will miss the runway after flying just one mile. Passenger jets have crashed into mountains because they were a couple of degrees off. Slight miscalculations can have grave consequences.

As we grow in faith, small departures can take us far away from where we started. But my interest in this illustration today is how powerful small adjustments toward better habits can benefit us. We tend to think that big decisions, like those made at the beginning of a new year, are what make the difference. That's true to a degree.

The decision to become a Christian, for example, brings that great and eternal blessing of salvation. But we overlook the importance of the small actions and minor decisions that over time add up to powerful attitudes and actions. My grandfather memorized one verse each night before bedtime. He wound up memorizing the whole New Testament. Read one chapter in the Bible a day and you'll have it read in 3 years and 3 months. Or read three a day to accomplish it in a year.

The small action of speaking about God to one person a day, or inviting someone to a Bible study, means that in a year 365 people will have had an introduction to faith or an opportunity to explore the truth. Over the course of a few days, for example, I shared a recent issue of our Brazilian magazine about Jesus with 13 different people.

A big word in some circles todays is "mindfulness." Sometime we just need to look for opportunities, however small. Brazilians have a saying, "grain by grain the chicken fills its gullet." When we make small changes for righteousness and for the good, we'll soon discover that good overflows from our lives.
