Report on Our Web Site

It has been nearly three years since we started the New Boston Church of Christ's web site. On a weekly basis, I upload my sermon outlines, audio of the sermons, videos of all the Bible classes and sermons, bulletin articles, and the bulletin itself. This has produced a tremendous amount of literature over the past three years, and our web site has grown because of it. We averaged about 10,000 visitors in 2015. In 2016, we had 14,000 visitors. In 2017, we have already had over 21,000 visitors, and the year isn't even over. The most popular spiritual item on the web site is the sermon outline: "The Comfort of God's Presence." Our bulletin is also very popular.
