think Jesus would not really care whether or not we had any candles in our churches."

Reading Allen's words brought a flashback. I was a college student preaching on Sunday for a small church. Week after week the ladies would vie with one another to see who could bring the most beautiful bouquet out of their garden. These offerings were generally placed in front of the pulpit (a lovely addition which I didn't mind at all). Then one Sunday there was one of the largest bouquets of gladiolus (a favorite flower of mine) which I had ever seen. As I stood up to preach, I suddenly discovered that I couldn't see the congregation. Being young and inexperienced, and not yet knowledgeable about the unpardonable sin, I lifted the arrange-

ment and placed it on the ledge of the baptistery behind me. It was an unwitting, but big mistake. Flowers, you see, must always be in front of the pulpit. Even then I wondered if it really made any difference to Jesus.

What was most important to Jesus? He answers "For I have come down from heaven, not to do my own will, but the will of him who sent me." (John 6:38). Shouldn't that be our focus as well? I do recall that our Lord said, "For whoever does the will of my Father in heaven is my brother, and sister, and mother" (Matthew 12:50).
