**Trip to Costa Rica**

“And He said to them, ‘Go into all the world and preach the gospel to every creature’” (Mark 16:15).

July 7<sup>th</sup> through 21<sup>st</sup>, I am scheduled to take a mission trip to Costa Rica. I have been planning this trip since early spring, and it is exciting that it is finally here. On this mission trip I will be teaching in the *Theological Institute of Costa Rica*, a school of preaching located in the town of Coronado. The Coronado Church of Christ, located in the Central Valley of Costa Rica just outside the capital city of San Jose, hosts this school. It is directed by a graduate of the Memphis School of Preaching and Freed-Hardeman University, Rafael Barrantes. He is a native Costa Rican who has spent many years in the United States and has just recently returned to direct this effort. My role in the school will be to teach the books of 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> Thessalonians, and to teach a class about how to use electronic media to preach and teach the gospel. The class on 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> Thessalonians will meet in the afternoon for 3 hours Monday through Friday for two weeks. The class on the use of electronic media will meet in the evenings. I will teach in English, and a translator will interpret into Spanish. Since beginning full-time preaching in 2002, this will be my sixth trip to Costa Rica to engage in teaching the gospel. I am grateful to the elders for permitting me the time to go, to Rafael Barrantes for the invitation, and to God for the opportunity to lift up His Son Jesus Christ to the people of Costa Rica. After I return, I will present a report to the congregation on my teaching efforts. Please pray for a safe and successful trip.

**The Blessings of a Short-Term Memory**

Often in life, the things that occupy our minds end up bringing us anxiety, stress, and eventually health problems. The Bible gives us direction from our Maker to deal with life's only real consequential problem: sin, but it also helps us deal with other issues we face as well; we are instructed to pray. Personal instructions for prayer include: 1 Peter 5:7 "Casting all your care upon him; for he careth for you." and Philippians 4:6 "Be careful for nothing; but in every thing by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known unto God."

We can all make mountains out of molehills. Our perception is limited, and we are constrained to work inside our limited knowledge. God, however, has perfect perception, and perfect and complete knowledge. We have tremendous advantage offered to us in our access to Him. (1Tim 2:5; Heb 4:16) Consider the power of prayers Luke records in Acts 4:31;8:15;12:5; and 16:25.--Inspired and Inspiring!

Truly, if we would pay attention to our Master, the Lord Jesus, his sermon on the Mount in Matthew 6 & 7 helps us put things in perspective with prayer. The Father knows our needs before we ask him (6:8), gives good gifts to His children (7:7,11; James 1:5, 17), and grants us peace of mind when we have poured out our soul unto Him (Mat 6:6,18; 1Sam 1:18; Phil 4:7). In times of turmoil, persecution, and unmistakable need, we can be anchored with "the peace that passeth understanding." Full confidence and tranquility of mind can only come by remembering doing as God says about prayer. Then, can we forget those things that would encumber us. We can leave them behind.
