Their Deeds on Their Own Heads

Ezekiel 9 is a vision of God's servants' cleansing Israel. God tells a servant with an inhorn to put a mark on the forehead of all of those who "sigh and cry over all the abominations that are done within [the temple]" (Ezekiel 9:4). These are spared. He tells his servants with battle-axes to kill the rest and to "begin at My sanctuary." Ezekiel laments the loss of God's people, but God responds, "My eye will neither spare, nor will I have pity, but I will recompense their deeds on their own head" (Ezekiel 9:10).

The interpretation of this vision is in Ezekiel 11:14-21. God explains that He will gather His people from where they have been scattered and give Israel to them. God says, "Then I will give them one heart, and I will put a new spirit within them, and take the stony heart out of their flesh, and give them a heart of flesh, that they may walk in My statutes and keep My judgments and do them; and they shall be My people, and I will be their God" (Ezekiel 11:19-20). What will be the fate of the rest? "But as for those whose hearts follow the desire for their detestable things and their abominations, I will recompense their deeds on their own heads," (Ezekiel 11:21-22).

Peter alludes to Ezekiel's prophecy in 1 Peter 4:17: "For the time has come for judgment to begin at the house of God; and if it begins with us first, what will be the end of those who do not obey the gospel of God?" For the wicked, who will not change their hearts and turn to God, their deeds are on their own heads. David understood. He wrote, "Behold, You desire truth in the inward parts...." (Psalm 51:6).

Let's continue to pray for workers and campers as well as travelers and vacationers. jp

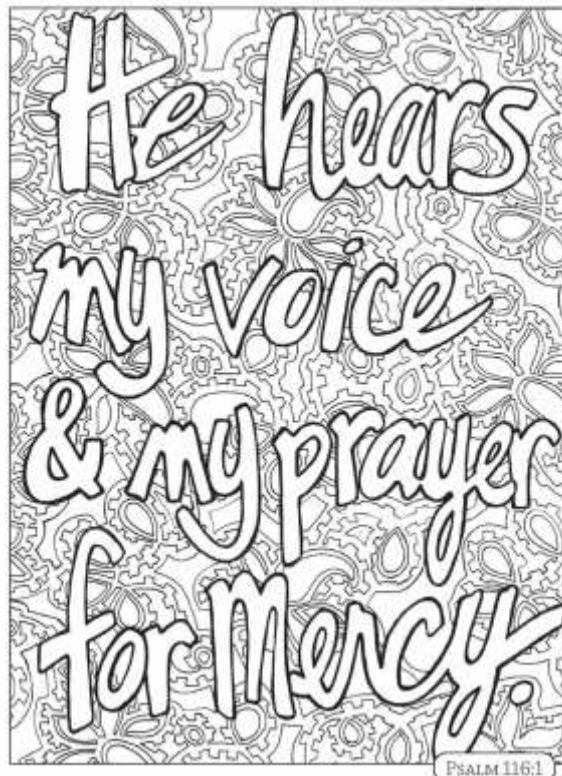

Americans are concerned every year about the prevalence of dirt here on earth. We fear germs and bacteria so much that we spend billions every year on cleansers, disinfectants, and antiseptics. We scrub, clean, sanitize, sterilize, and deodorize because we know dirt can be dangerous and even deadly to physical life. But germs and bacteria are not the only kind of dirt around. Sin, in all its many manifestations, has dirtied and diminished our world. Sin is not sanitary. It dirties the soul. But, thank God, a cleanser is available. "If we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fel-

lowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus Christ cleanses us from all sin" (1 John 1:7). If you don't wash your hands, you threaten your body's health, and maybe the health of others. The same is true of your soul. We apply the cleansing power of Jesus' blood when we respond to his call to "Arise and be baptized, and wash away your sins, calling on the name of the Lord" (Acts 22:16). In 1899 Lewis E Jones said in song what John saw in Heaven: "There is power, power, wonder-working power in the blood of the Lamb; in the precious blood of the Lamb."
