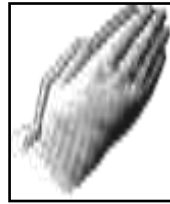

A Mighty Fortress

I am fascinated with some strategy games. I'm not much good at them, necessarily, but I enjoy them. Many strategies used in these games have roots in actual tribal, city, city-state, or national warfare. Early in the Civilization computer game I like to play sometimes, there is a quote provided when the player discovers the *masonry* technology: "It is from their foes, not their friends, that cities learn the lesson of building high walls--*Aristophanes*". We exist in such a measure of security that we do not know what it is like to build a wall or to live near a fortress from necessity. The use of fortresses has a long view and farsightedness toward victory. This use looks beyond the initial conflict and predictable losses. Well fortified cities often contained storehouses and provisions within so that residents could outwait a siege. The defensive strength of the fortifications had to exceed the strength of the force that was attacking, else the demise of all within. It is worth considering, though, that 1 Peter 5:7 speaks of one who would devour us. There is a real and necessary struggle for survival, but God is our refuge if we trust and obey Him. One of the benefits provided by the adversity Satan is that we "learn" to trust God more than we would otherwise--more surely than Mesopotamians and others learned centuries ago to trust in their city walls.

We have no strength, safety, or expectation of survival apart from God; however, we have these things without measure when we trust and obey Him. Our confidence is not misplaced when we rely on God to help us through trials and temptations. James advises us to "Draw nigh unto God, and He will draw nigh unto you; resist the Devil, and he will flee from you." See also Heb 13:6. Jesus offers that which is truly worthwhile in "life, and that more abundantly" (John 10:10); He pleads for the weary and heavy laden to come to Him (Mat. 11:28-30) for rest. Troubled? Beset? Suffering? Come inside the Fortress!
