1. We should live soberly, righteously, and godly, in this present world; (Titus 2:12b)
2. Pure religion and undefiled before God and the Father is this, To visit the fatherless and widows in their affliction, and to keep himself unspotted from the world. (James 1:27)
3. Not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as the manner of some is; but exhorting one another: (Hebrews 10:25a)
4. And beside this, giving all diligence, add to your faith virtue; and to virtue knowledge; (2 Peter 1:5)
5. Naked, and ye clothed me: I was sick, and

8. But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, gentleness, goodness, faith, Meekness, temperance: against such there is no law. (Galatians 5:22-23)

9. For when for the time ye ought to be teachers, ye have need that one teach you again which be the first principles of the oracles of God; and are become such as have need of milk, and not of strong meat. For every one that useth milk is unskilful in the word of righteousness: for he is a babe. But strong meat belongeth to them that are of full age, even those who by reason of use have their senses exercised to discern both good and evil. (Hebrews 5:12-14)
