Chris Hooten and Christians at the Highland Church in Texarkana presented Moses from the basket to the 10 commandments for their annual Children's Day in August. Peggy Hooten challenged us to borrow their props and visuals and present the same theme for Learning to Serve. It was an ambitious undertaking and required a lot of people and a lot of cooperation, but it worked. The children were engaged, attentive and could readily answer review questions at the end of the day.

The format involved keeping all the children in one group as Mr. Bible (Scott Hobson) led them from one scene to the next. He served as the narrator who filled in the history between the scenes. The first stop was a visit with Jochebed (Danielle Tyndell) who explained why and how Moses was placed in the river to be rescued by the princess. After fleeing Egypt as an adult and herding sheep in Midian, Moses (Blake Tyndell) encountered the Burning Bush and the Voice of God (Scott Overstreet). After recruiting his brother, Moses and Aaron (Sawyer Hobson) appeared before Pharoah (Kevin Cauley). Then came the ten plagues. Shara and Sommer Hobson explained each plague aided by the artistic depictions created by artists from the Highland congregation. To help their memory each child was given a memento to remind them of each plague. Thanks to Peggy Hooten for locating and assembling all the items. Before the Passover feast of roasted meat and flour tortillas, the children changed into cardboard sandals crafted by MaryLynn Cauley and her helpers. They ate the meal standing up so they would be ready to leave Egypt when the Pharoah said they could go. They fled through the sheets representing the Red Sea. Unfortunately for the Egyptian soldiers, the sheets collapsed and drowned them. After escaping through the Red Sea and out the back door, they wandered through the wilderness of the South parking lot, back through the front door where they waited at the foot of Mt. Sinai as Moses received the 10 commandments.

The children who shared the experience are Drake, Zain, Josie, Deacon, Sabrina, Carter, Ellie, Sammy (also helped set up the props and participated in one of the skits), Jordan, Jamiya, Landrie, and Lexi.
