Obedience and accountability

Chapter 24 of Acts relays to us a summary of Paul's preaching before Felix. Verse twenty-five says he "reasoned of righteousness, temperance, and judgement to come." Let's briefly consider this content from Paul's lesson on obedience and accountability.

"Righteousness" has to do with our taking action by aligning ourselves with what is just toward God and our fellow man. God has plainly told us what to do and what not to do, expecting us to invest ourselves in seeing His will done. Do we apply ourselves toward this? Have we taken the time to discern what God wants us to do? Righteousness demands that we walk looking outwardly as well as inwardly. God has spoken unto us in these times through His Son (Heb 1:1-3). Have we hearkened (listened) to Him?

"Temperance" likewise takes effort. Sometimes called self-control, temperance is manifested as we are careful to *not* do whatever we want to do. The appetites of the flesh are "bridled," or kept under control. When a person has temperance, things that are desirable to the flesh are either excluded or enjoyed only as God has stipulated.

"Judgment to come" constantly acknowledges the truth of God's promise to judge the world in righteousness by that man He has ordained. It means we should live responsibly, because that is what good stewards do. Poor stewards are punished when they are called to give account. When we direct our time, talents, and money for God's intended purposes, we are a holy people. (2Pet 3)

We should acknowledge our accountability to the One who made us. We are to submit to the commands of God. He expects and deserves our obedience. Putting all this aside is the easy way out, and feels liberating. However, making selfish choices like this makes us servants of sin unto death (Rom 6). Felix chose this way by putting off hearing Paul again until a so-called "convenient season." jp
