Itching Ears

Second Timothy 4:3-4 states "For the time will come when they will not endure sound doctrine, but according to their own desires, because they have itching ears, they will heap up for themselves teachers; and they will turn their ears away from the truth, and be turned aside to fables." However, when the Bible contradicts our desires, we need to be corrected to bring our desires in line with the Bible's teaching. Jesus said, "As many as I love, I rebuke and chasten. Therefore be zealous and repent" (Revelation 3:19).
