Our Spring Gospel Meeting Countdown Has Begun!



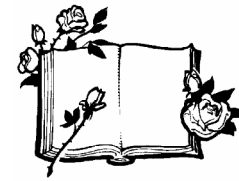
