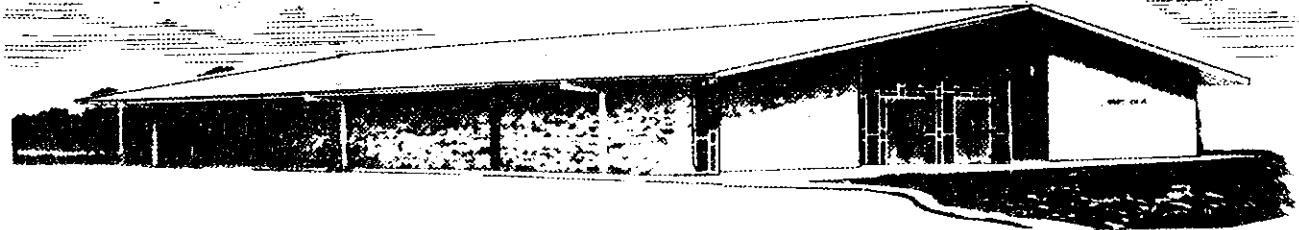

TEENAGE SPRING BANQUET

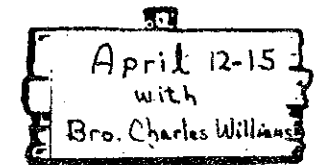
