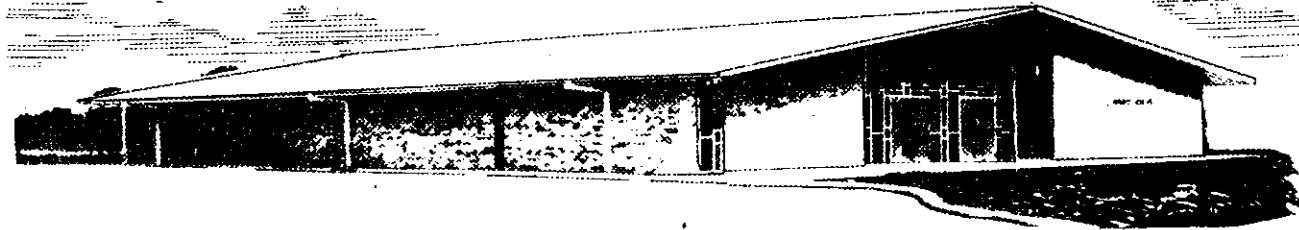


# HAPPENINGS in God's Family
