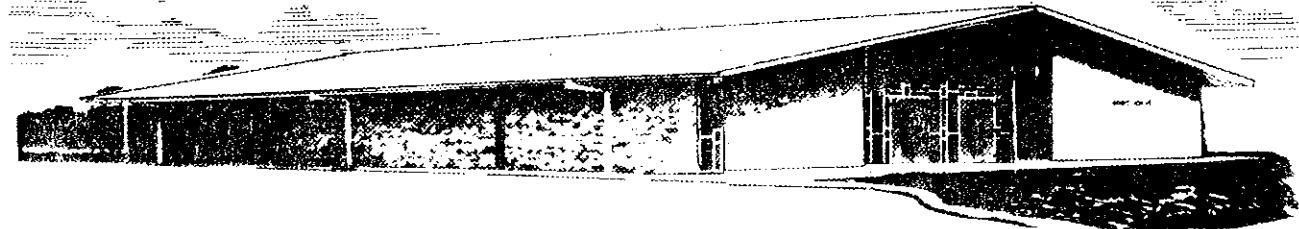

SERVICES CANCELLED

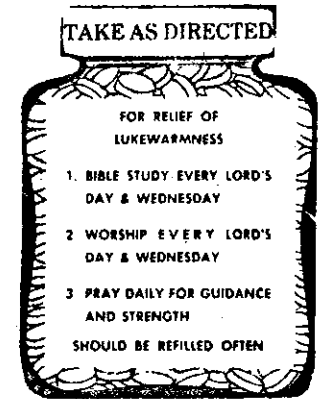
Due to icy roads and streets our services were cancelled last Wednesday evening. I hope you missed not meeting together, and we look forward to continuing all studies next Wednesday.
