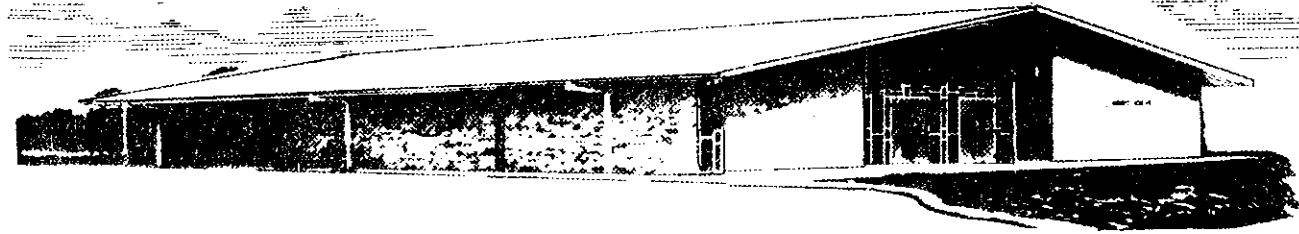

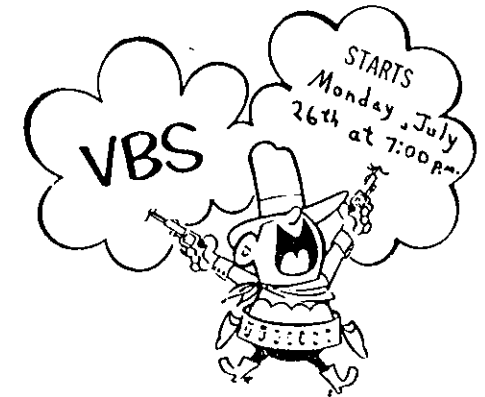

AT HOME: Bobby Jo Higginbotham; Sarah Jo Vance; Marie McPherson; Melvin Watkins; and Blanche McClung.

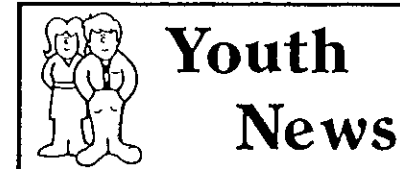
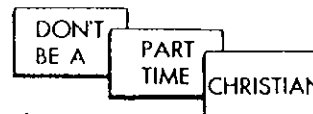
VBS REFRESHMENT LIST

CARE Group 5 will meet at the City Park immediately after services this Sunday evening.

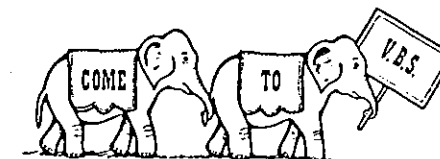


The Summer Youth Series is at Northside this week, and James Hawk will speak about "One Among Many."
