Who We See in the Pew

The great challenge of assembling is to see one another as God would have us to be, not as sin distorts us. There will be times when our neighbor has not been able to comb his or her hair. Some may not have such a pleasant odor about them. Others will have blunt speech that grates on our ears. If these are the things that we notice, then we are in danger, for we are not looking at things the way that God looks at them, but from our own selfish desires for how we think others should be. "My brethren, do not hold the faith of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Lord of glory, with partiality" (James 2:1).

What we should see are people who have been redeemed by the blood of Christ with whom we want to have a full and complete relationship. That is what God sees through Christ Jesus, and it is only looking at one another from this perspective that we can be the body of believers that God wants us to be. This was John's perspective in 1 John 1:3-4, "that which we have seen and heard we declare to you, that you also may have fellowship with us; and truly our fellowship is with the Father and with His Son Jesus Christ. And these things we write to

you that your joy may be full." Our joy can only be full when we look at one another in this way. Who do we see in the pew around us? Let's adjust our perspectives.

It is our responsibility to make sure we are plowing in the right direction, doing the most good, serving the right Master, cooperating with the right team, and heading in the right Way. (John 14:6). In short, the **Bible** is the only legitimate Spiritual orthosis (James 1:25). It answers all the great questions of life, as well as corrects all the mistakes we make (John 12:48). Under the yoke of Christ, we expend our energies toward a desired end: Heaven with our Savior! Whatever the figure: bearing a yoke, bearing a cross, or putting our hand to the plough, it is a joy to perceive the love of God in our existence here and in eternity. Only He will provide rest from labor. He is the God of all comfort (2 Cor 1:3-4; Isa 61:2; Mat 5:4). Even labor can be a joy as love is behind it. (Genesis 29:20) Anguish and sorrows can be forgotten (John 16:21).

Satan's deception would have us believe in the happiness of liberty from being told what to do. Mankind has largely bought into this lie. Pleasures of sin are only for a season (Heb 11:25). The two paths of Matthew 7:13-14 as well as the two destinies mentioned in Matthew 25:31-46 don't leave any room for misunderstanding. Our repentance is demanded and completely necessary (Acts 2:38; 3:19; 17:30). We should all seek to have and maintain correctable hearts.

Finally, we must reach out to others to take up the yoke of Christ. Our work is not done until this life is over (2 Tim 4:6-8; Heb 9:27; Eccl 12:7; Rev 3:19-21). jp
