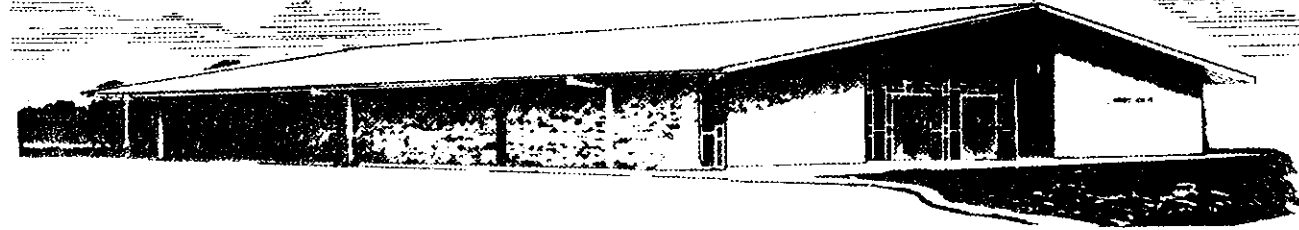

ATTENTION COORDINATORS

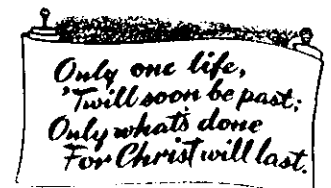
Please review the VBS kits in the office if you have not done so. We must make a decision regarding curriculum soon, and return the kits we will not use.
