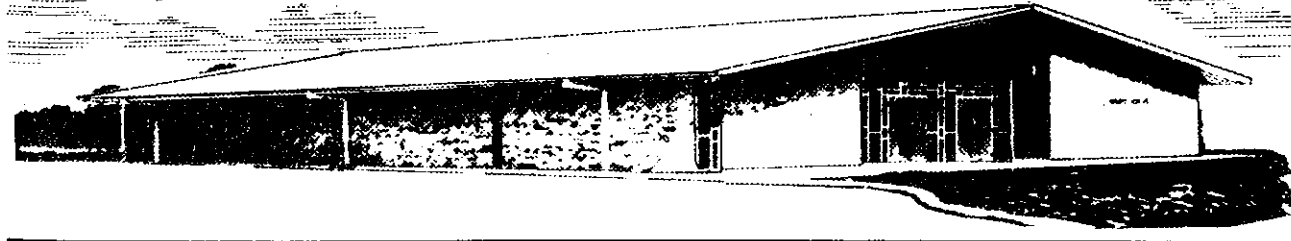

OUR BUDGET

The inside page shows our projected budget for 1982, and also the amounts we have spent to date. We have already exceeded our projections in some areas, therefore, it is essential that we meet or exceed our budget. I do not believe that our present budget is unreasonable; in fact, I believe it is too low. We need to take seriously our giving to the Lord. There is no way we can be considered to be "faithful Christians" if we are not giving faithfully and generously.

We exceeded our budget each month from January to June. Since June we have been under our budget each month. The average contribution for July, August, and September was \$ 1100.51 per week.

Since we have gained new families we should be doing better than we were doing earlier in the year. The only logical conclusion is that some of our number have lowered their contribution, or else ceased to give altogether. I'm sure there are those who are not giving on a regular basis. Brethren, we need to seriously consider our allegiance to the Lord in this area!

We need to realize the responsibility we have to the church as a member of the body of Christ. I hope YOU will make every effort to be present for both services this Lord's Day. The morning lesson would be a good one for your friends to hear.

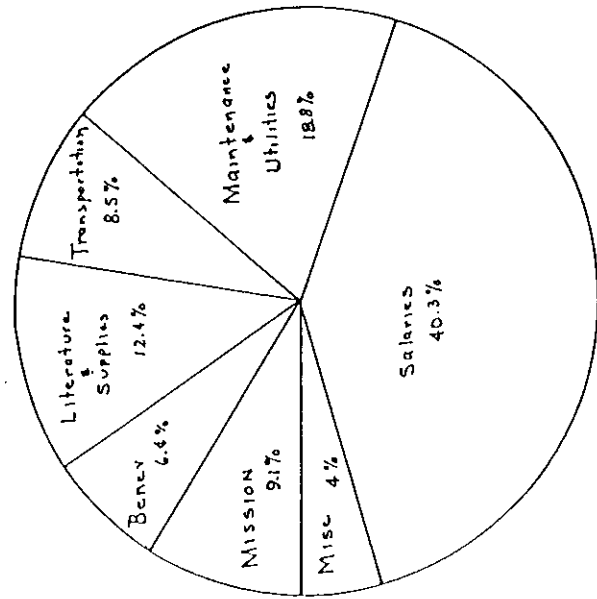

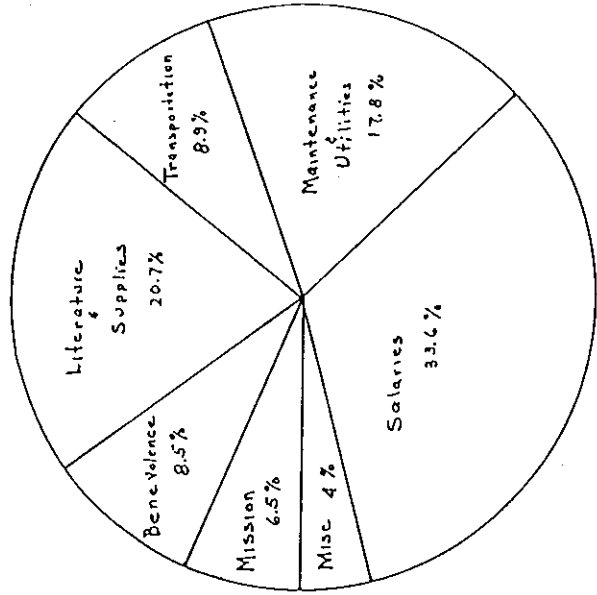
