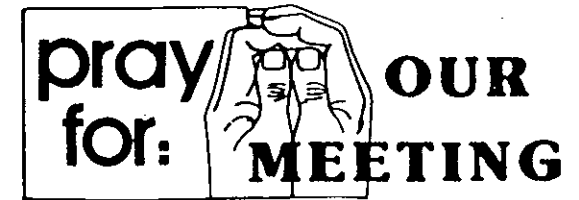
My Dearest Christian Friends,
