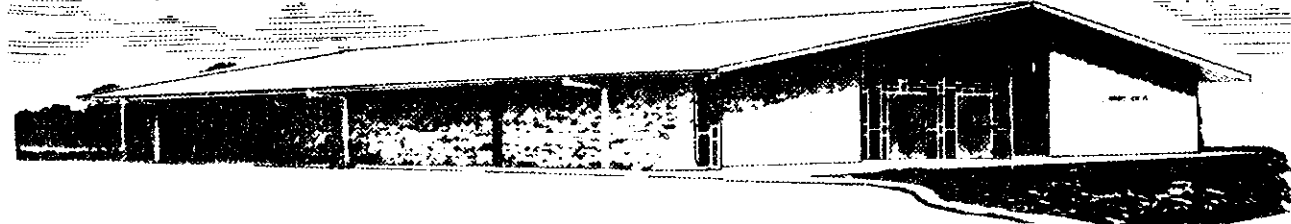

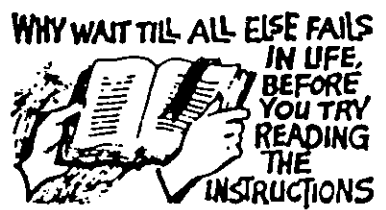

Also, our sympathy goes to Danny Ward of DeKalb at the death of his father. Services were Sunday at Bates-Rolf Funeral Home in DeKalb.



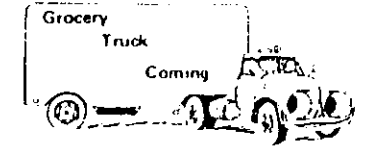
