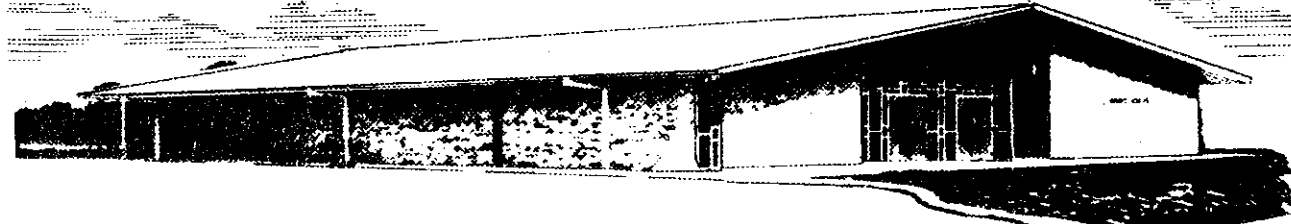


HAPPENINGS in God's Family
