For even hereunto were ye called: because Christ also suffered for us, leaving us an example, that ye should follow his steps: Who did no sin, neither was guile found in his mouth: Who, when he was reviled, reviled not again; when he suffered, he threatened not; but committed *himself* to him that judgeth righteously: Who his own self bare our sins in his own body on the tree, that we, being dead to sins, should live unto righteousness: by whose stripes ye were healed. **Jesus' Greatness**

Men who stood nearest to Jesus were swayed by His personality. He was "full of grace and truth" (John 1:14). He had a charm about Him which wooed and fascinated.

Children liked Him; publicans hung upon Him. He had the heart of a child, the tenderness of a woman, the strength of a man.

The three dimensions (body, mind, soul) of His were complete. His forgiveness was unbounded; His generosity was untiring; His patience was inexhaustible; His mercy was immeasurable; His courage was illimitable; His wisdom was unfathomable; His kindness was interminable; His faith removed mountains; His hope had no shadow in it; His love was infinite.

And so, it is impossible to go beyond Him. We can never outgrow Him. He will be always ahead of us. We shall always hear Him saying, "Follow me!" He is the ideal of the heart. He is the goal of humanity. It is this completeness of His character which accounts not only for His beauty but also for His perennial power. His is the lily of the valley, the fairest of ten thousand, and one altogether lovely.
