Our (Wednesday) Bible classes

The Wednesday night adult Bible class has been exploring the topic "How God inspires faith". We have covered the introduction and two lessons now, by utilizing time from Sunday morning on the 11th. Lesson 2 was/is How God inspires faith with His Word. There are quite a few subtopics left to be explored, as God has provided evidences and reassurances time and again in scripture that He is to be trusted and obeyed.

The examination of our own faith is beneficial. Do we still believe in God? Why? Do we still believe in Jesus as the Son of God? Why? Can we still find good reasons to reach the conclusions we did in the past? 1 Peter 3:15 commands us to "sanctify the Lord God in your hearts: and be ready always to give an answer to every man that asketh you a reason of the hope that is in you with meekness and fear:"

We must examine ourselves. God's expectations are that we grow spiritually, not that we stagnate or get complacent. As we are doers and not hearers only, we look into the perfect law of liberty for a REAL standard (James 1). We must find (Do others see?) Christ in us as we examine ourselves (2Cor 13:5).
