Does the Universe exhibit the properties of design?




"I will give thanks unto thee; For I am fearfully and wonderfully made: Wonderful are thy works; And that my soul knoweth right well" (Psalm 139:14).

"It's a parts list with a lot of parts. If you take an airplane, a Boeing 777, I think it has like 100,000 parts. If I gave you a parts list for the Boeing 777 in one sense you'd know a lot. You'd know 100,000 components that have got to be there, screws and wires and rudders and things like that. On the other hand, I bet you wouldn't know how to put it together. And I bet you wouldn't know why it flies."

"Well we're in the same boat. We now have a parts list. That's what the human genome project is about is getting the parts list. If you want to understand the plane you have to have the parts list but that's not enough to understand why it flies. Of course you'd be crazy not to start with the parts list."

DNA the molecule of life

Trillions of cells


Each cell:

46 human chromosomes

2 meters of DNA

3 billion DNA subunits (the bases: A, T, C, G)

Approximately 30,000 genes code for proteins that perform most life functions



• The Encyclopedia Britannica contains 30 volumes of information or about 10⁷ bits of data.

 Microsoft's Operating System, Windows 10 has over 50 Million Lines of Code or about 10⁸ bits of data.



- The genetic code contained in one cell is approximately 10¹² bits of data and each person has approximately 10¹⁴ cells in their body.
- This is equivalent to the number of letters in the world's largest library of about 10 million books.
