The Action of Brotherly Love—

- a) We must love one another as the Lord loved us, John 13:34; 15:12. He loved us enough to give his life. (John 3:16). What are we willing to give up for our brother in Christ?
- b) We are to love one another as we love ourselves, Matthew 22:39. c) We are to love one another fervently, 1 Peter 1:22; 4:8. The word “fervent” means intense, earnest, assiduous. The word “assiduous” means performed with constant diligence or attention; persistent, devoted, attentive, and unremit-

ting. d) We are to love one another genuinely, 1 Peter 1:22, 23. e) We are to love one another with a pure heart, 1 Peter 1:22, 23. Our hearts are to be pure from envy, malice, hatred, animosity, jealousy, ill-will, etc. f) We are to love one another in deed and not in word only, 1 John 3:17, 18. Now, see Galatians 6:10; Luke 10:30-37; Matthew 25:31-46; and Acts 11:27-30. g) An analysis of 1 Corinthians 13:4-8 will help us to understand the action of our love toward our brethren. 1974, *Toward Spiritual Maturity*, chapter 9, pages 62-63
