How to Overcome Fear-part 1

- Remember that fear is strictly prohibited. (Deut 1:21; Gen 15:1; Isa 44:8; Psa 91:5; 1 Pet 3:13-15; Luke 12:4,7,32; John 14:27; Rev 1:17-18; 2 Tim 1:7) In fact, fear is a characteristic of the wicked (Prov 28:1). "Fear not" and "be not afraid" appear in the Bible almost 180 times. Thus, to fear is to disobey God.
- 2) Enthrone Christ. In 1 Pet 3:14, the apostle exhorts the early disciples not to fear. Then, in vs. 15 he tells them how this is done: "But sanctify in your hearts Christ as Lord." (American Standard Version). The same instruction is given in Isa. 8:11-13. With Christ enthroned in our hearts we need not fear to live, for He is the living one; we need not fear death, because He died and is alive forevermore; and, we need not fear the hereafter, for He has the keys of hades and of death. (Rev 1:17,18).
- Put your faith and trust in God. (Prov 3:25,26; 29:25; Ps 56:11; 112:7; 46:1-3; Matt 8:26; 2 Tim 1:12; Isa. 12:2). Faith is the foe of fear. It is either faith or fear! (Isa 26:3).
- 4) Conceive of God as a Father. (Matt 6:9; 7:7-12; Rom 8:15). What child has not had his fears allayed on some dark night when he slipped his hand into his father's and walked with him side by side?
- 5) Never lose sight of the fact that you are in the presence of God and that His help is nigh. (Psa 46:1, 2; 23; Gen 26:24; Isa. 35:4).
- 6) Rest in the love of God (Eph 3:17-19; Rom 8:28-39). "I know not where his islands lift their fronded palms in air. I only know I cannot drift beyond His love and care."
- 7) Take courage in the fact that God is on your side and will fight for you. (Deut. 20:1; 31:6; Neh 4:14; 2 Kings 6:16; Exodus 14:13, 14). "The Lord is on my side; I will not fear: what can man do unto me?" (Psa 118:6). "If God be for us, who can be against us?" (Rom 8:31).
- 8) Never take counsel of your fears. A general who was fearful of an attack planned in the Shenandoah Valley, and expressed his fears to Stonewall Jackson, was told by the courageous Jackson, "General, never take counsel of your fears." Instead of doing that, why not with Paul say, "I can do all things through Christ which strengtheneth me." (Phil 4:13).
