When good things increase, those who consume them increase. So what is the advantage to their owners except to look on?" Satisfaction doesn't come in getting what you want; it comes in wanting what you already have.

“Tagging along” with the thoughts from the first of Barry Haynes’ articles on the front, I would make mention of **two** of our Lords’ insights on the Judgement Day. The first is given in Matthew 7, verses 21-27. Jesus tells us what “many” will say to Him in that day—”Lord, have we not Done many wonderful works?” He concludes the Sermon on the Mount with an admonition unto obedience. He says we are wise to obey, given the warnings of punishment (consequences) for disobedience and the blessings for obedience. The second is His narrative at the end of Matthew 25. Those upon the right hand and left hand are quoted —”When did we/did we not minister...?”

Objections raised in that Day—“but”, “have we not”, “when did we not”—are answered with truth, bringing dawning realizations from the delusions people live under commonly: “I give enough”, “I have a special understanding with God”, “I am an exception”, “The people made me”, “Everyone else was doing it” It is literally infinitely better (wise!) to wake up to these things now, repent, and warn others with the loving words of our Savior! **jp**
