God Wants you to Flourish!

God gave Adam and Eve this command, "Be fruitful and multiply; fill the earth and subdue it" (Genesis 1:28). For this to happen, Adam and Eve needed to move beyond the status quo. They needed to flourish. The word flourish means to thrive and prosper. It means to reach one's full potential as a human being. God has the same desires for us today. We need ambition in spirituality! One's desire to flourish in pursuit of his own personal desires should be multiplied in spiritual matters. William P. Merrill wrote, "Rise up, O men of God! Have done with lesser things. Give heart and mind and soul and strength to serve the King of kings." We need Christians to come forward and lead the church today. Let's not wallow around waiting for others to step up but fill the void ourselves.


