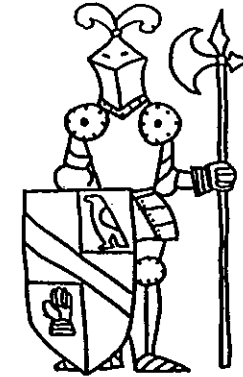
### ELDERS MEETING
