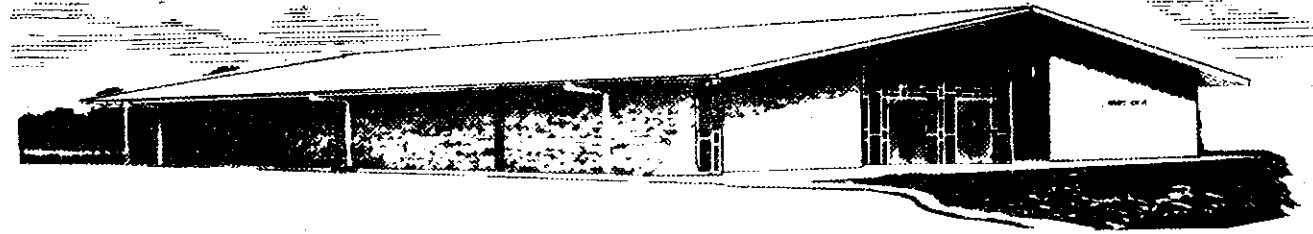

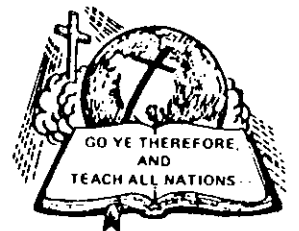
Be sure and assemble with the saints this Lord's Day.

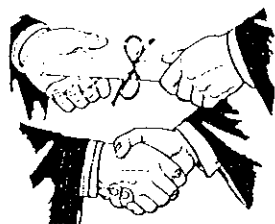
