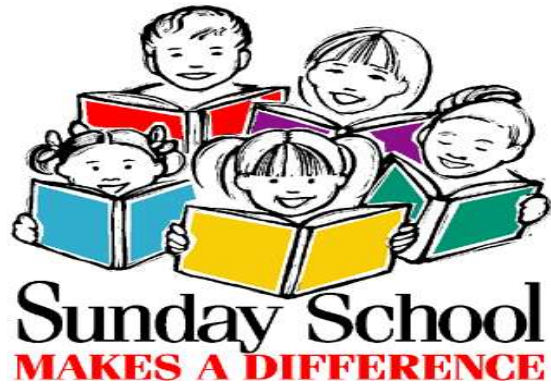

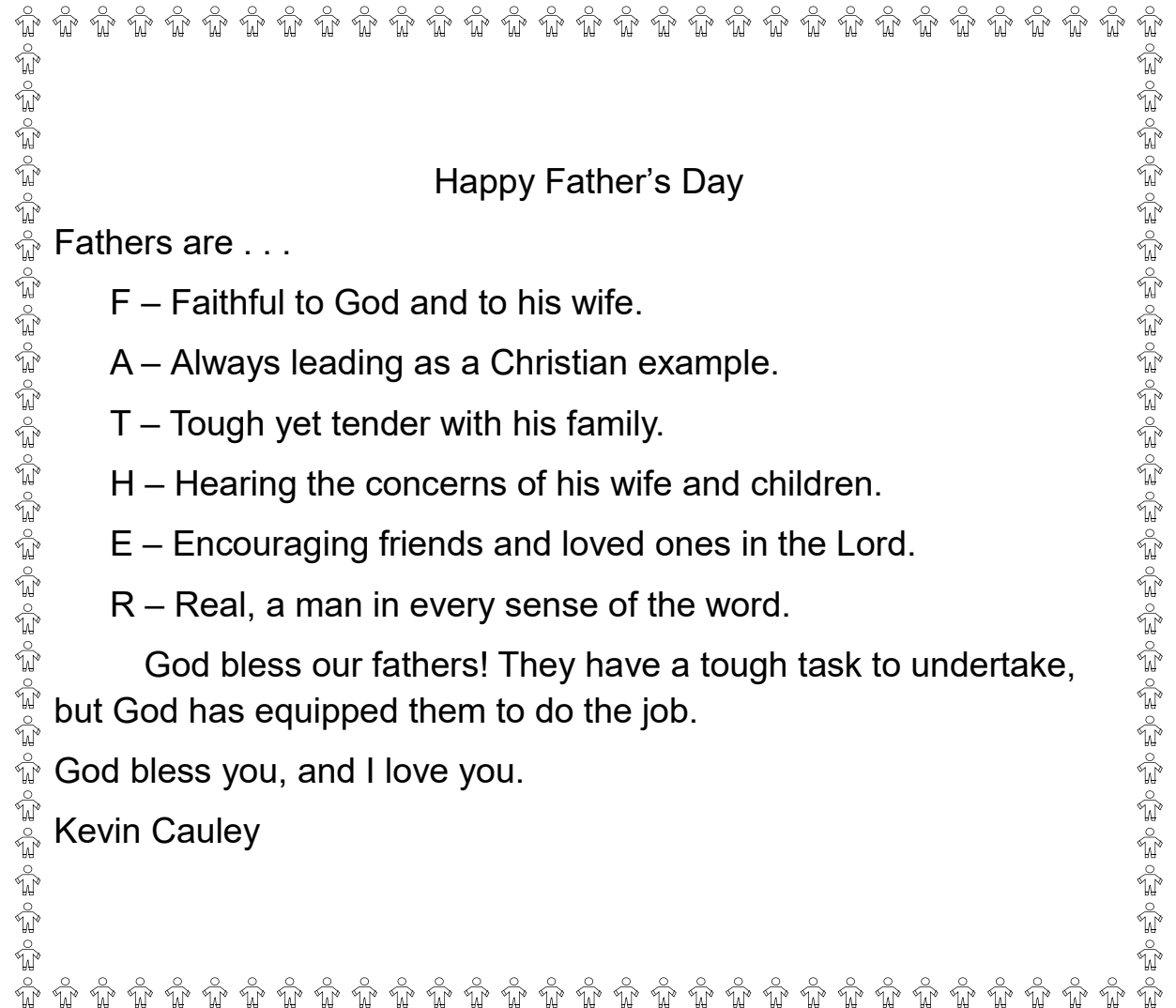

Mistaken choices and honest errors are forgivable in our day-to-day living. They happen, and usually without dire consequences. However, in matters of the faith, where eternity (our soul) hangs in the balance, our “calling and election” should be sure. We do well to have a foundation worth building upon. The philosophies, opinions, and traditions of men ought not be consulted as authoritative. God’s Word tells us how we should live (Deuteronomy 8:3; Matthew 4:4). We can teach this to our humble children very well with the story of Naaman in 2 Kings 5, but with many, stubborn pride will eclipse the lesson altogether. A refusal to recognize the path we have chosen is a course of destruction or oblivion surely shortens the path getting there. Pharaoh’s hardened heart shows this process—how decidedly self-destructive we can be just by insisting we have our own way.
